How Much Do I Need?

First find the square footage of the area you want to cover
 Example (8 feet x 8 feet area 2 inches thick) $8 \times 8 = 64$ square feet
 Divide the 64 by the corresponding number shown below:
 In this case it is 162 since we are wanting it 2 inches thick
 64 divided by $162 = .40$ cubic yards of product

Divide the square footage by	54	to get 6 inches of product
Divide the square footage by	65	to get 5 inches of product
Divide the square footage by	81	to get 4 inches of product
Divide the square footage by	108	to get 3 inches of product
Divide the square footage by	162	to get 2 inches of product
Divide the square footage by	324	to get 1 inch of product

OR USE THESE GUIDELINES FOR FIGURING

1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	27 sq ft at 6 inches thick
1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	32.5 sq ft at 5 inches thick
1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	40.5 sq ft at 4 inches thick
1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	54 sq ft at 3 inches thick
1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	81 sq ft at 2 inches thick
1/2 a cubic yard (1 scoop) will cover	162 sq ft at 1 inches thick

1 SCOOP IS APPROX 1/2 A CUBIC YARD

4 scoops (2 cubic YARDS) will fill out the bed of a full size pickup
 **This is to be used as estimator only, product settling and variations in depth of the ground will come into play
